SUB: Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report on e-voting conducted pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended from time to time for the Annual General Meeting of Carrier Airconditioning Refrigeration Limited ("Company") held on Friday, September 8, 2023, at 12:00 P.M. through video conferencing ('VC') / other audio visual means('OAVM').

Dear Sir,

- 1) The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on Wednesday, August 09, 2023 have appointed us as Scrutinizer pursuant to section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, and all other provision as applicable, to scrutinize the remote e-voting and e-voting conducted at its Annual General Meeting ("AGM") in fair and transparent manner.
- 2) In accordance with General Circulars No. Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, 2/2021 dated January 13, 2021, 19/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 21/2021 dated December 14, 2021, 2/2022 dated May 5, 2022 and 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022 issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (hereinafter referred "MCA Circulars"), physical attendance of the shareholders to the AGM venue is not required and general meeting may be held through Video Conferencing ("VC") or Other Audio Visual Means ("OAVM").
- 3) The Company had engaged Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") as the service provider, for extending the facility of electronic voting (Remote evoting and e-voting facility provided during the AGM) to the shareholders of the Company.

- 4) The remote e-voting process was started on Tuesday, September 5, 2023 at 09:00 A.M. and ended on Thursday, September 7, 2023at 5:00 P.M.
- 5) We have monitored the process of e-Voting through the scrutinizer's secured link provided by CDSL through its designated website.
- 6) On completion of the e-voting during the AGM, the report on e-voting done at the AGM and the votes cast under remote e-voting facility prior to the AGM were unblocked by me in the presence of two witnesses who were not in the employment of the company and were counted and we have downloaded the e-voting report from the website of CDSL in respect of the shareholders, who voted through the e-Voting.
- 7) We have scrutinized and reviewed the remote e-voting and e-voting facility provided to shareholders during the AGM and votes cast there in based on the data downloaded from the CDSL e-voting system.
- 8) As on September 01, 2023 i.e. the **cut-off date**, there were 5,733 shareholders of the Company who were entitled to vote on the resolutions placed for the approval of the shareholders through remote e-voting as well as e-voting facility provided at the AGM of the Company.
- 9) The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, the Rules including MCA Circulars relating to remote e-voting prior to and e-voting during the AGM on the resolutions contained in the notice of the AGM ("Notice").
- 10) Our responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process (Remote e-voting and e-voting facility provided during the AGM) is restricted to making Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "in favor" or "against" the resolutions contained in the Notice, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by CDSL.
- 11) We now submit the consolidated Report as under on the result of the remote evoting and e-voting done during the AGM in respect of the said resolutions.
